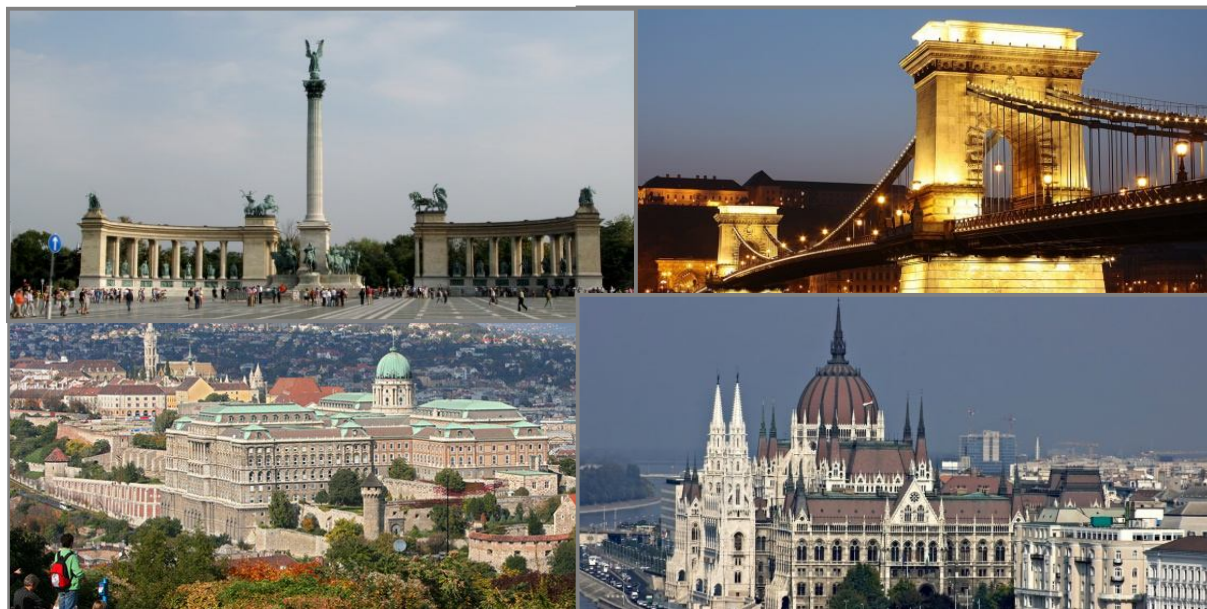

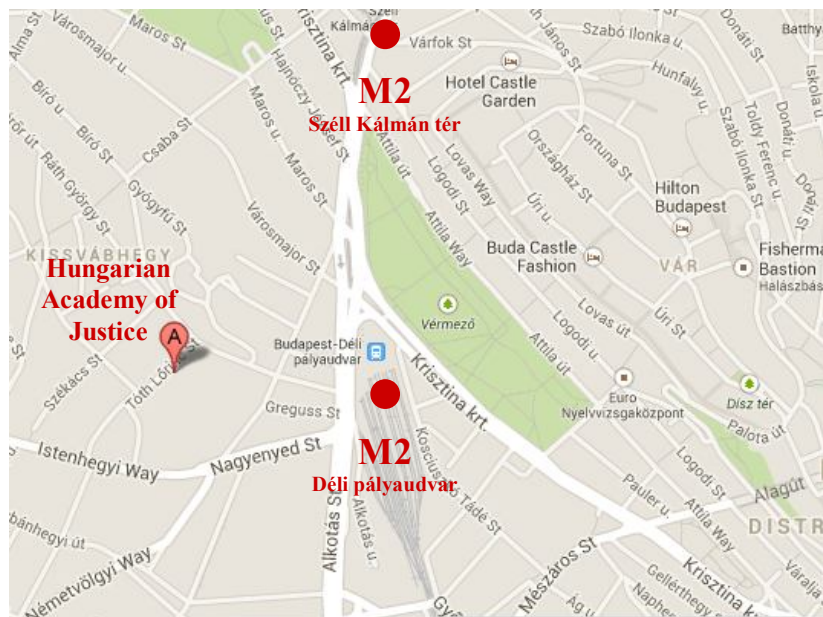

Airport Shuttle Minibus Service

Find the red Airport Shuttle-Minibus Desk Service at the exit of Liszt Ferenc International Airport.



Check-in at the reception desk with your destination address: *Budapest-1122 (XII. district) Tóth Lőrinc u. 6.* **Fares:** 5.200 HUF (17 EUR) one way, 10.000 HUF (33 EUR) return (EURO currency is accepted, payment can be made by credit card). After you have bought your ticket, take a seat and your ticket number and destination address will be called.

General Tourist Information

Currency – HUF, exchange rate is approx. 1 EUR = 300 HUF.

Local time –Standard Time Zone in Hungary is Central European Time, GMT+1 (CET).

Electricity supply – Standard voltage in Hungary is 230V; electricity outlets have two round contact points. Appliances operating on other voltage or provided with different type of end points require an adapter.
